SUMMARY

Human trafficking has become a more recognizable form of illegal activity now to date. In cases involving the missing Washington DC girls and stories of young women becoming mysteriously missing, coming out with wearable tech to help decrease the rate has come to our attention. 80% of human trafficking victims are female and half of that percentage is children. That is approximately 600,000 to 800,000 abductions per year. Human trafficking generates \$150.2 billion in illegal profits.

Integrating tracking and wearable tech may help keep women from becoming missing person cases. Designing stylish wearable jewelry and/or any other forms of subtle wearables that will be hard to detect.

DEVICE

With a ring, the user can discretely hide the device under. Through many tests, the conclusion that a ring will be better used as a tracker compare a smartwatch or bracelet. 
Messages seem pointless since these friends will be already calling or texting on the phone. The purple is a little harsh. It was difficult to read with the white text on light purple.




This is a nice feature but maybe add a feature that shows how active we are. I would like to see how active I've been.


Add a cancel button if the user accidentally taps emergency. Add a timer too for when the user is not by phone.

I think "stay in place" should be "find a safe place". If the user is in the middle of the danger, they shouldn't stay in place. They should hide.



Can we tone down the black in the background? It is a strong contrast to the "Share Location".




I recommend either enlarging the text or make it thicker. It is hard to read.








We removed the background image to use the negative space to our advantage. We also thicken the text a tad.
